If technical provisions really are prudent after allowing for any weakness in the employer's covenant, the length and shape of the recovery plan are open for agreement between the trustees and the employer.

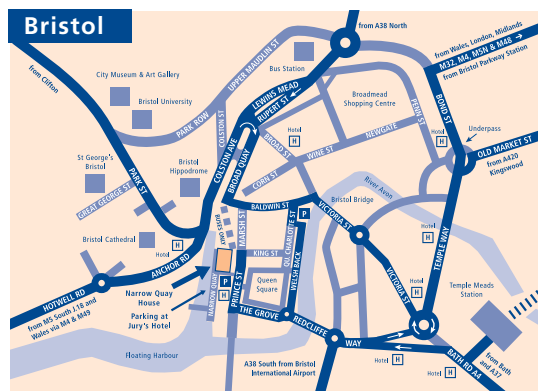

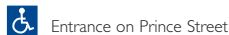
## Bristol seminar location map
